Do you like having guitar lessons?

Yes, I do. I love having guitar lessons.

No, I don't. I hate having guitar lessons.

Does he like chatting online?

Yes, he does.

No, he doesn't.

Interrogative	Full answers
How often do I swim?	I swim every day .
How often do you swim?	You swim every week .
How often does he swim?	He swims every weekend .
How often does she swim?	She swims every month .
How often does it swim?	It swims every Saturday .
How often do we swim?	We swim every year .
How often do you swim?	You swim every day .
How often do they swim?	They never swim.

How often does she play in the school band?

She plays in the school band **every month**.

How often do they chat online? **Never**.

Affirmative	Negative
I'm good at singing.	I'm not good at singing.
You're good at singing.	You aren't good at singing.
He's good at singing.	He isn't good at singing.
She's good at singing.	She isn't good at singing.
It's good at singing.	It isn't good at singing.
We're good at singing.	We aren't good at singing.
You're good at singing.	You aren't good at singing.
They're good at singing.	They aren't good at singing.

Interrogative	Short answers
Am I good at singing?	Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.
Are you good at singing?	Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.
Is he good at singing?	Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.
Is she good at singing?	Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.
Is it good at singing?	Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.
Are we good at singing?	Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.
Are you good at singing?	Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.
Are they good at singing?	Yes, they are. / No, they aren't.
